PRAYER FOCUS

(10th -13th February 2020)

What difference would there be amongst us, if each of us had an encounter with the Father where we were impacted by the extravagance of His love for us? ... (Ephesians 3:18-19)

Cry out for that encounter! Pray Ephesians 3:16-21!

Prayer theme for each day:

Monday:

- **Prepare the Way for Him ... Clear the obstacles** (Isaiah 57:14-15)
- **Come to Me and Drink** (John 4:10-26 & John 7:37-39)

Tuesday:

- **Living under the cloud of Glory** (Exodus 40:34-38)
- **God wants to inhabit His people** (1 Peter 2:4-10)

Wednesday:

- **All together in one place - clothed with power.** (Acts 2:1- 4,14 -21)
- **They raised their voice together in prayer** (Acts 4:23-31)

Thursday:

- **A People of One Heart and One Mind.** (Acts 4:32-35)

God's heart cry:

- **Prepare the Way for Him ... Clear the obstacles.** (Isaiah 57:14-15)
 - Repentance
 - Humility(Consider 1 Peter 5:5, Galatians 5: 22-26, Romans 12: 1-3)

- **Come to Me and Drink** John 4: 10-26 & John 7:37-39

Questions to ponder ...

- How thirsty are we?
- We need to learn how to actually drink from Him ...
- How do we worship in Spirit and in truth?
- What actually is worship and what is it that we are worshipping?

- **God wants to inhabit His people.** Living stones being built into a spiritual temple. (Exodus 40:34-38 & I Peter 2:4-10)

We need to catch God's heart for the Body of Christ - a company of people not just separate individuals who happen to meet together..

Are we willing to sacrifice to build into this body?

Are we prepared to consecrate ourselves as a body to see Him dwell in us corporately? (This is about how we conduct our relationships with one another... Consider Ephesians 4: 1 & Philippians 2:1-11)

- **The Spirit is clearly saying: Live together in unity of heart and purpose!** (Acts 2:1-4 & 14-21: Acts 4:23-35)

A key area for repentance is the cleansing of our tongues. We need a Baptism of fire that will cause life to flow from our hearts and out through our mouths so we build each other rather than cut down.

- **God is Sovereign. In the trials and tribulations we face, He is Redeemer. He is committed to advancing His Kingdom and demonstrating His compassion and Power.** (Acts 4: 23-31)

God has a plan and purpose in the midst of any opposition we face.

Are we prepared to pursue His mission whatever the cost knowing that He will empower us and manifest His Kingdom as we go?

Revival always is about heart change ... repentance and the restoration of holiness in lifestyle. It is about the restoration of first love.
